Students have already had sessions on various wellbeing-related issues as part of our sixth form assembly, tutor and enrichment programmes and our Sixth Form Information Evening on Wednesday 12 October will include wellbeing-related information for parents. He has a background in education and is an ex-headmaster who now devotes his time and passion to promoting positive mental health in young people.
