Dear Parents

As part of JCGs internationalism activities we will be launching an international summer school programme targeting global leadership and entrepreneurship. The JCG LEAP Summer School.

The programme will bring together female students from around the world to develop business management, creativity and entrepreneurial skills while developing social enterprise projects to target key global issues. The idea is that these projects will then be undertaken within the IWA Club network and so be real and sustainable.

We will be having the first programme for 30 students here in Jersey in July / August 2017 and are targeting full sponsorship for all students. This will enable us to invite students from both privileged and underprivileged locations and have them work together with our JCG students as equals.

We believe it will be really powerful. Imagine, multi-national teams of girls working collaboratively to develop social change projects and then actually executing them in a global sustainable network, having developed the skills to do this through the programme.

The Foundation is seeking sponsorship for the programme from a number of corporations and foundations and has already secured some initial funding.

We would also like to open up the programme to individual sponsors or perhaps families who would like to sponsor and host one of the international students attending.
